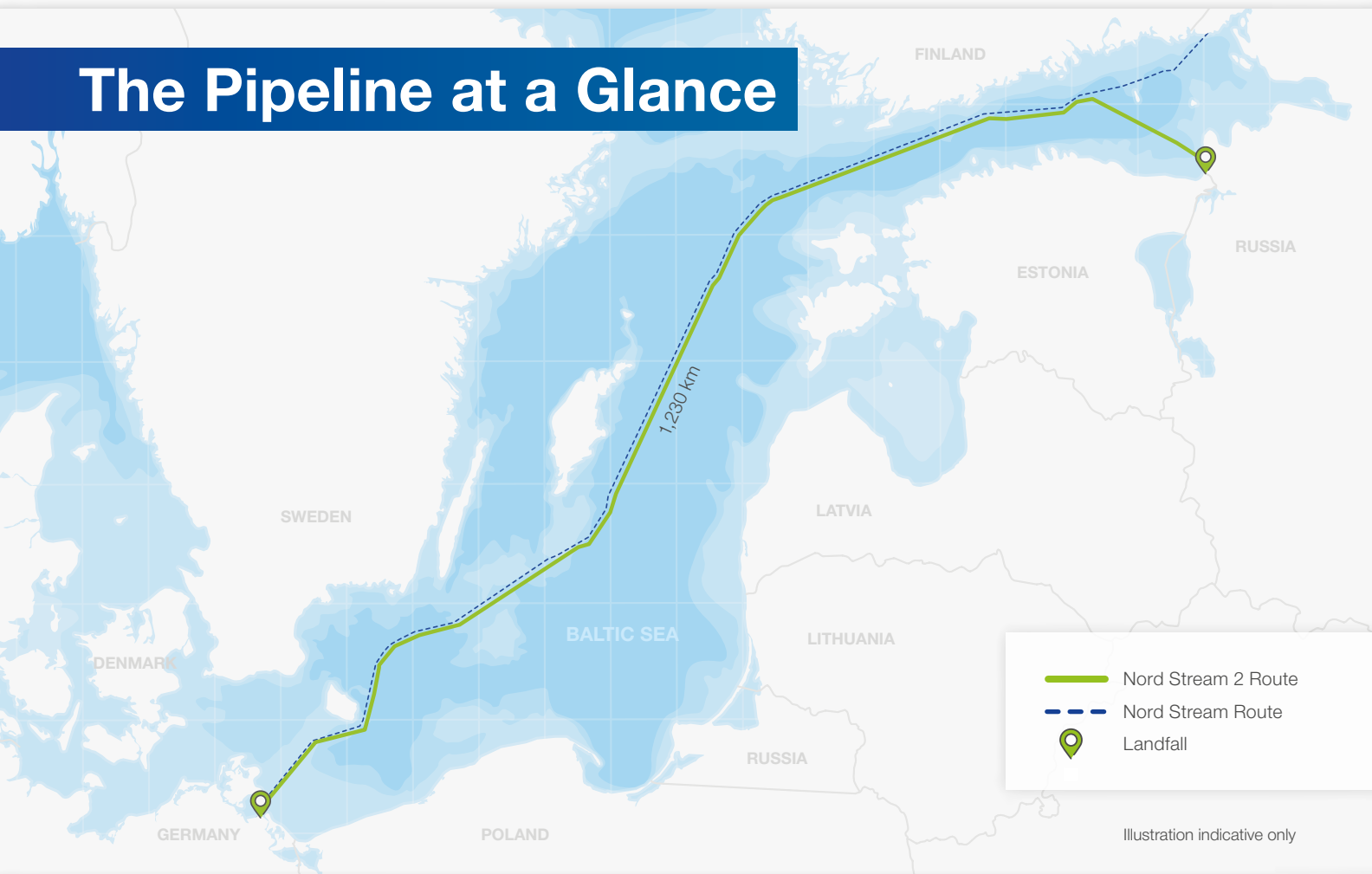

The Pipeline at a Glance



Overview: A major international infrastructure project bringing natural gas from the world's largest reserves in Russia to meet European energy needs.

A proven concept: Safety and environmental protection come first in the meticulous construction plan, which builds on the experience of the successful Nord Stream Pipeline. Each step has been tailored to local conditions after extensive research and planning.

Economic benefits: Working with 600 contractors worldwide, the project will bring 31,000 jobs and investments of €5 billion to the EU.

Meeting future gas demand: With EU domestic gas production declining, new supplies and infrastructure are needed to fill the import gap in a reliable, affordable and sustainable manner. With an annual capacity of 55 billion cubic metres (bcm), the pipeline will enhance security of supply, support climate goals and strengthen the internal energy market.

An international company: Based in Switzerland, with 200 employees from over 20 countries.

Construction: Summer of 2018 to late 2019

Financing: Initiated by Russian gas producer Gazprom with backing from five major European energy companies.
